In Russia, a strong black tea called zavarka is served with sweet snacks like cakes or cookies.



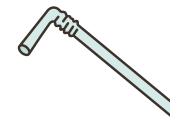
In Pakistan, a pink chia tea is made with pistachios, spices, and baking soda.

In Argentina, maté tea is made from the yerba maté plant and is drunk through a special straw called a bombilla.



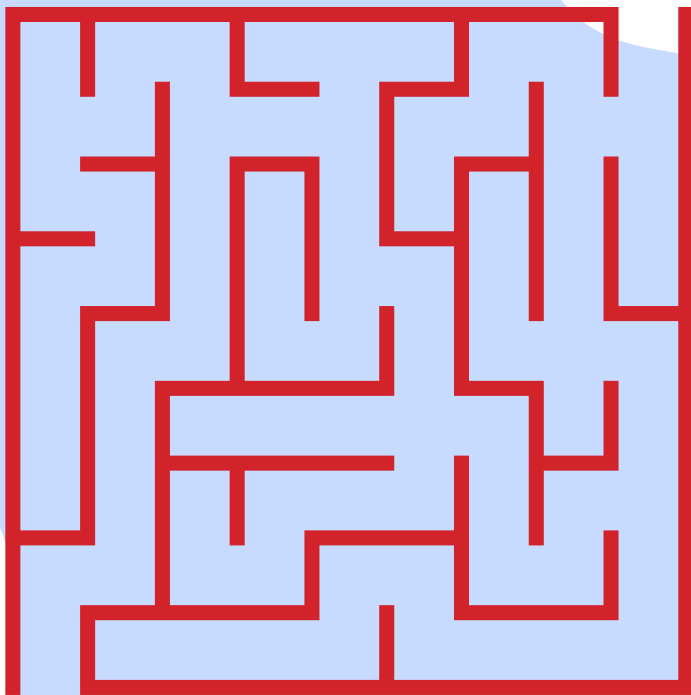
In India, masala chai tea is flavored with spices like cinnamon, ginger, and pepper.
